





Fine Imposed in connection with noncompliance of securities laws
BSEC News: BSEC has imposed fine of Tk. 10.00 lac to Mona Garments Limited (Corporate Director of Purabi General Insurance Company Ltd.) for non-compliance with Securities laws in connection with selling of 5,09,709 shares without prior declaration which violated BSEC Notification No. SEC/CMRRCD/2009-193/49/Admin/03-48 dated July 14, 2010 and SEC/CMRRCD/2009-193/119/Admin dated November 22, 2011.

Approval of BMRE and set-up of units, plants at the factory

The Company has informed that the Board of Directors has decided for 1) BMRE of 18,000 MT Per annum Capacity of Sulphuric Acid Plant Unit- 1, 2) Establishment of New Aluminium Sulphate (ALUM) Plant Unit- 2 for 12,000 MT Per annum and 3) Linear Alkail Benzene Sulphonic Acid/Sodium Lauryl Ether Sulphate (SLES) Plant for 7,200 MT per annum at its Factory Narayangonj. Approval has been given for obtaining necessary finance of Tk. 50.91 crore from Agrani Bank Ltd., Principal Branch, Dhaka. Board has also approved for establishment of a poly Aluminium Chloride Plant of 4,500 MT Per Annum at the Factory Premises.

Bangladesh will become a 100 per cent poverty and hunger-free country by 2030 as various poverty alleviation programmes are being implemented across the country. Finance Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal made the expectation on Monday at a discussion on at the Bangladesh Bank (BB) headquarters in the city, reports BSS.
